

AMENDMENTS TO LB 925

(Amendments to Standing Committee amendments, AM2604)

Introduced by Hudkins, 21

1 1. Insert the following new section:

2 Sec. 5. Section 60-4,182, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska, is amended to read:

4 60-4,182 In order to prevent and eliminate successive
5 traffic violations, there is hereby provided a point system dealing
6 with traffic violations as disclosed by the files of the director.
7 The following point system shall be adopted:

8 (1) Conviction of motor vehicle homicide - 12 points;

9 (2) Third offense drunken driving in violation of any
10 city or village ordinance or of section 60-6,196, as disclosed by
11 the records of the director, regardless of whether the trial court
12 found the same to be a third offense - 12 points;

13 (3) Failure to stop and render aid as required under the
14 laws of this state section 60-697 in the event of involvement in a
15 motor vehicle accident resulting in the death or personal injury of
16 another - 6 points;

17 (4) Failure to stop and ~~render aid~~ report as required
18 under the laws of this state section 60-696 or any city or village
19 ordinance in the event of a motor vehicle accident resulting
20 in property damage if such accident is reported by the owner
21 or operator within twelve hours from the time of the accident
22 - 4 6 points; 7 otherwise - 8 points, and for purposes of

1 ~~this subdivision a telephone call or other notification to the~~
2 ~~appropriate peace officers shall be deemed to be a report;~~

3 (5) Driving a motor vehicle while under the influence
4 of alcoholic liquor or any drug or when such person has a
5 concentration of eight-hundredths of one gram or more by weight of
6 alcohol per one hundred milliliters of his or her blood or per two
7 hundred ten liters of his or her breath in violation of any city or
8 village ordinance or of section 60-6,196 - 6 points;

9 (6) Willful reckless driving in violation of any city or
10 village ordinance or of section 60-6,214 or 60-6,217 - 6 points;

11 (7) Careless driving in violation of any city or village
12 ordinance or of section 60-6,212 - 4 points;

13 (8) Negligent driving in violation of any city or village
14 ordinance - 3 points;

15 (9) Reckless driving in violation of any city or village
16 ordinance or of section 60-6,213 - 5 points;

17 (10) Speeding in violation of any city or village
18 ordinance or any of sections 60-6,185 to 60-6,190 and 60-6,313:

19 (a) Not more than five miles per hour over the speed
20 limit - 1 point;

21 (b) More than five miles per hour but not more than ten
22 miles per hour over the speed limit - 2 points; and

23 (c) More than ten miles per hour over the speed limit -
24 3 points, except that one point shall be assessed upon conviction
25 of exceeding by not more than ten miles per hour, two points shall
26 be assessed upon conviction of exceeding by more than ten miles per
27 hour but not more than fifteen miles per hour, and three points

1 shall be assessed upon conviction of exceeding by more than fifteen
2 miles per hour the speed limits provided for in subdivision (1) (e),
3 (f), or (g) of section 60-6,186;

4 (11) Failure to yield to a pedestrian not resulting in
5 bodily injury to a pedestrian - 2 points;

6 (12) Failure to yield to a pedestrian resulting in bodily
7 injury to a pedestrian - 4 points; and

8 (13) All other traffic violations involving the operation
9 of motor vehicles by the operator for which reports to the
10 Department of Motor Vehicles are required under sections 60-497.01
11 and 60-497.02, not including violations involving an occupant
12 protection system pursuant to section 60-6,270, parking violations,
13 violations for operating a motor vehicle without a valid operator's
14 license in the operator's possession, muffler violations,
15 overwidth, overheight, or overlength violations, motorcycle or
16 moped protective helmet violations, or overloading of trucks - 1
17 point.

18 All such points shall be assessed against the driving
19 record of the operator as of the date of the violation for which
20 conviction was had. Points may be reduced by the department under
21 section 60-4,188.

22 In all cases, the forfeiture of bail not vacated shall be
23 regarded as equivalent to the conviction of the offense with which
24 the operator was charged.

25 The point system shall not apply to persons convicted
26 of traffic violations committed while operating a bicycle or an
27 electric personal assistive mobility device as defined in section
