Enrollment and Review Change to LB 54

3 The following changes, required to be reported for publication
4 in the Journal, have been made:

5 1. In the Schimek amendment, AM0304:

6 a. Sections 15, 16, 19, 21, 22, 24, 29, 33, 34, and 35 have
7 been renumbered as sections 17, 18, 21, 23, 24, 26, 31, 35, 36, and
8 37, respectively;

9 b. On page 11, line 7, "the" has been struck and shown as
10 stricken;

11 c. On page 14, the matter beginning with "8" in line 23
12 through "34" in line 24 has been struck and "10 to 13, 15, 21 to
13 28, 30 to 34, and 36" inserted; and

14 d. On page 15, line 5, "48-227, 48-229," has been inserted
15 after the second comma.

16 2. In the Schimek amendment, AM0428, amendment 2 has been
17 struck.

18 3. On page 1, the matter beginning with "veterans" in line 1
19 through line 13 has been struck and "government service; to amend

26 to redefine terms relating to veterans; to change provisions for a
27 veteran hiring preference and qualifications for veterans'
28 benefits; to reorganize provisions relating to veterans; to modify
29 exemptions for veterans; to clarify eligibility for veterans'
30 benefits; to eliminate a retraining program; to harmonize
31 provisions; to provide operative dates; to repeal the original
32 sections; to outright repeal section 81-1393, Reissue Revised
33 Statutes of Nebraska; and to declare an emergency." inserted.
