Enrollment and Review Change to LB 382

3 The following changes, required to be reported for publication
4 in the Journal, have been made:

5 1. The Stuhr amendment, AM0816, as amended by the Stuhr
6 amendment, FA154, has been incorporated into the Standing Committee
7 amendments, AM0702.

8 2. In the Stuhr amendment, AM0816, on page 6, the matter
9 beginning with the semicolon in line 16 through the last quotation
10 mark in line 17 has been struck.

11 3. In the Byars amendment, AM0951, on page 1, line 19, "13
12 and 15" has been struck and "15 and 17" inserted.

13 4. In the Standing Committee amendments, AM0702:

14 a. On page 58, line 14, "signature" has been inserted after
15 "electronic"; and

16 b. On page 66, line 24, "effective date of this act" has been
17 struck and "operative date of this section" inserted.

18 5. On page 1, the matter beginning with "drugs" in line 1
19 through line 10 and all amendments thereto have been struck and
20 "public health and welfare; to amend sections 71-168, 71-1,146.01,
21 71-1,147.35, 71-374, 71-375, 71-5402, 71-5403, and 71-5404, Reissue
22 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, sections 28-401, 28-405, 28-414,
23 28-1437, and 71-1,142, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2004, and
24 section 2, Legislative Bill 306, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First
25 Session, 2005; to provide for electronic transmission of
26 prescriptions; to define, redefine, and eliminate terms; to change
27 provisions relating to controlled substances, dispensing,
28 compounding, and destroying certain drugs, and drug product
29 selection; to provide an exception to mandatory reporting
30 requirements for pharmacist interns; to change provisions relating
31 to the Board of Cosmetology; to provide for relabeling and
32 redispensing of certain prescription drugs and devices; to change
33 provisions relating to criminal background checks required of
34 certain professionals; to harmonize provisions; to provide
35 operative dates; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an
36 emergency." inserted.
