LB 1201 would have amended sections 77-3508 and section 77-3513 to expand the number of individuals eligible for homestead exemptions under the handicapped provisions. The individuals newly eligible for relief were to be those who are blind under federal income tax code definitions, meaning 20/200 or a field of vision of ten degrees or less.
