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**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 810 would have amended section 77-2715.07 to allow a refundable credit against the income tax for resident individuals equal to twenty percent of any credit allowed under section 32 of the IRC. That is the earned income tax credit. The bill was to be operative for all tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2006.
