LB 202 provides for the use of a joint license plate issuance system in the 90 counties that currently issue plates by the county number system, beginning on the effective date of the bill. Counties opting to use the joint system may not issue any more plates using the county system than were issued in the last year in which only the county system was used. The remainder of the plates issued by counties using the joint system must be alphanumeric.

The Department of Motor Vehicles will have one-time computer programming expenses to modify the Vehicle Titling and Registration system and the database that manages license plates. The estimated cost is \$38,625 in 2005-06.
