A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to trade practices; to amend section 87-210,  
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change  
3 provisions for trade name registration; and to repeal the  
4 original section.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1.   Section 87-210, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   87-210.   (1) Subject to the limitations set forth in  
4 sections 87-208 to 87-220, any person who adopts a trade name for  
5 use in this state may file in the office of the Secretary of State  
6 on a form furnished by the Secretary of State an application, in  
7 duplicate, for registration of the trade name setting forth, but  
8 not limited to, the following information:

9                   (a) The name and street address of the applicant for  
10 registration; and, if a corporation, the state of incorporation;

11                   (b) The trade name sought to be registered;

12                   (c) The general nature of the business in fact conducted  
13 by the applicant;

14                   (d) The length of time during which the trade name has  
15 been used in this state;

16                   (e) The signature of the applicant; ~~which must be~~  
17 ~~acknowledged before a notary public;~~ and

18                   (f) A filing fee of one hundred dollars.

19                   (2) Upon compliance by the applicant with the  
20 requirements of sections 87-208 to 87-220, the Secretary of State  
21 shall return the duplicate copy stamped with the date of filing to  
22 the applicant or the representative submitting the applications for  
23 filing.
