A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to civil procedure; to amend section
2 25-1629.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
3 provide for service of juror summons by first-class mail;
4 and to repeal the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 25-1629.04, Reissue Revised Statutes
2 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 25-1629.04. After a proposed jury list has been
4 selected, the jury commissioner may require that each person listed
5 on the proposed jury list be served with a summons, issued by the
6 jury commissioner, to appear before the court at a time and place
7 certain for jury duty. The jury qualification questionnaire may be
8 sent together with the summons in a single mailing to a prospective
9 juror. The summons may be served upon each juror by first-class,
10 certified, or registered mail, or by personal service by a jury
11 commissioner, the clerk, or other person authorized by the court.
12 After the initial appearance of the juror, he or she shall appear
13 for jury service in any court of the county as directed by the
14 judge of any court during the term of jury service of the juror.
