A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
2 28-507, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to burglary; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-507, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-507. (1) A person commits burglary if such person
4 ~~willfully, maliciously, and forcibly breaks and enters any real~~
5 ~~estate or any improvements erected thereon~~ willfully and
6 maliciously enters or remains unlawfully in any building or
7 occupied structure, or a separately secured or occupied portion
8 thereof, knowing that he or she is not licensed or privileged to do
9 so and with intent to commit any felony or with intent to steal
10 property of any value.

11 (2) Burglary is a Class III felony.

12 Sec. 2. Original section 28-507, Reissue Revised
13 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
