LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 328

Introduced by Combs, 32

PURPOSE: The purpose of this study is to review the issues raised by LB 1030 (2006), as heard by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Ninety-ninth Legislature, Second Session. Issues addressed by this interim study may include, but are not limited to, the following:

(1) Determination of current procedures for inspection of public park buildings;

(2) Identification of essential inspection requirements for public park buildings;

(3) Examination of possible inspection exemptions for some public entities;

(4) The potential liability issues for cities; and

(5) The relationship, if any, of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 37-729 to 37-736 to the issues addressed by this study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its

recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
