LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 370

Introduced by Wehrbein, 2

PURPOSE: The purpose of this study is to continue the study conducted pursuant to LR 105, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First Session, 2005, of rural economic development issues in Nebraska. This study shall continue to examine rural economic development programs available to Nebraska residents and recommend the most effective way to deliver these programs across the state. The study shall include, but not be limited to:

(1) An examination of the success of state-funded programs and any recommendations for changes to the programs which could include elimination, consolidation, or changes in funding levels;

(2) Producing a compilation of a history of rural economic development policy in Nebraska to be made available to incoming senators; and

(3) An examination of ways to collaborate with other states to receive federal funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the members of the committee appointed in 2005 by the Executive Board of the Legislature pursuant to LR 105 be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of

this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
