LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 388

Introduced by Mines, 18

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to study whether Nebraska should enact the Uniform Residential Mortgage Satisfaction Act as promulgated by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws in 2004. In order to carry out the purpose of this resolution, the committee should seek and consider the input of interested persons as it deems necessary and beneficial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
