LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 394

Introduced by Schrock, 38

PURPOSE: The purpose of this interim study is to review the Nebraska Resources Development Fund in the Department of Natural Resources. The fund was created in 1974 to provide loans or grants to political subdivisions for projects that provide land and water resource benefits to the citizens of Nebraska. The study may include, but not be limited to, historical data regarding the use of the fund, an analysis of ongoing funding requirements, the effect of federal funding and state matching fund requirements upon project funding requests, the use of a financial cap to control the amount of funding that may be allocated to approved projects, and whether statutory and budgetary adjustments may be necessary to better address the effectiveness of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
