LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 418

Introduced by Erdman, 47

PURPOSE: The Legislature recognizes the importance of and economic impact that Interstate 80 has on the State of Nebraska, both to bring goods to the citizens of Nebraska and by providing goods and services to travelers from other states. The Legislature further recognizes that the vehicle towing and salvage industry plays an important role in providing services to travelers and for the safe operation of vehicles on the interstate.

The purpose of this study is to consider the steps that can be taken to support and develop the vehicle service and towing industry in Nebraska. This study shall include, but not be limited to, reviewing Nebraska laws and the laws of other states relating to abandoned vehicles and salvage of vehicles and gathering information on the number of and the procedures for clearing damaged and abandoned vehicles. Input shall be solicited from the Nebraska State Patrol, academic professionals, the towing industry, the trucking industry, automobile associations, and any other government agencies, groups, or individuals with relevant information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Transportation and Telecommunications

Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
