The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1156 would require school lands managed by the Board of Educational Lands and Funds at the end of the current lease period to be converted to dryland farming if those lands had been irrigated under the terms of the expired lease. This would apply only to those lands located in a river basin, subbasin or reach that has been determined by the Department of Natural Resources to be fully appropriated or has been designated overappropriated.
