The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1172 provides for the placement of road name signs on sign posts under the jurisdiction of the Department of Roads and in the state right-of-way when state highway visibility would not be impaired. This bill would allow for the efficient and economic placement of road name signs by local authorities and facilitate the identification of local roads by emergency medical providers, law enforcement, travelers and residents.
