Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 337

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Under current law, when a municipal county has been approved, non-participating municipalities can continue to exist for a period of four years without any threat of annexation by the newly created municipal county. During the same four year period, the non-participating municipality cannot annex any additional territory. LB 337 strikes these provisions.

In addition, this bill would require an affirmative vote of the electorate of the non-participating municipality before the non-participating municipality can be annexed by the municipal county.
