Introducer's Statement of Intent
LB 918

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 918 would define a security data breach as any unauthorized acquisition of, or access to, computerized data that compromises the security, confidentiality, or integrity of personal information maintained by either a person or a business. The bill would require a business to notify its consumers of a security breach in the most expedient time possible without unreasonable delay. However, a delay in notification would be allowed if it would hinder a criminal investigation.

LB 918 would also enable the Nebraska Attorney General to bring an action in the event of a breach, seek penalties, fees and costs.
