

LEGISLATIVE BILL 90A

Approved by the Governor May 26, 2005

Introduced by Wehrbein, 2; Stuhr, 24; Cunningham, 40

AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 90, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First Session, 2005; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$150,000 from the General Fund for FY2005-06 and (2) \$150,000 from the General Fund for FY2006-07 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program 134, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 90, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First Session, 2005.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$105,517 for FY2005-06 or \$105,517 for FY2006-07.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$850,000 from the General Fund for FY2005-06 and (2) \$850,000 from the General Fund for FY2006-07 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program 601, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 90, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First Session, 2005.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2005-06 \$850,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2006-07 \$850,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$250,000 from the General Fund for FY2005-06 and (2) \$250,000 from the General Fund for FY2006-07 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program 603, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 90, Ninety-ninth Legislature, First Session, 2005.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2005-06 \$250,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2006-07 \$250,000 General Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

Sec. 4. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$2,500,000 from the General Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund on or before June 30, 2006, or on such date as directed by the budget administrator. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$2,500,000 from the General Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund on or before June 30, 2007, or on such date as directed by the budget administrator.

Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
