SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Good morning.      Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Matt Sass, Evangelical Free Church in Hastings, Nebraska, Senator Burling's district. Pastor.

PASTOR SASS:      (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Pastor Sass, for being with us this morning, acting as our chaplain. Pastor Sass is from 33rd District, Senator Burling's district. I call the seventieth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence.

ASSISTANT CLERK:      There is a quorum present this morning, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections for the Journal, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK:      Mr. President, there's no corrections this morning.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports, or announcements?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, we now go to General File, 2005 committee first priority bills. Mr. Clerk, first bill would be LB 645.

ASSISTANT CLERK:      Mr. President, LB 645 was introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 19, referred to the Transportation, Telecommunications Committee. The committee reported the bill to General File with committee amendments attached.
