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yeah, what are you doing? He said, I'm sorry. He didn't give me the gun. He put it away and went the other direction. Does that mean he's not going to shoot somebody someplace else? I don't know every young black man. I cannot intervene in every situation like that. The police can and they know. They have snitches. You think they cannot tell who is bringing guns into my community? And I'm going to sit here and, to get along with you all, let the session go? I'm going to kill every bill, one way or the other, that I can, and I'll kill the session if I have to, and I'm going to lay on you and stay on you till you say something to the U.S. Attorney, till you say something to the FBI, till you say something to the chief of police. They go into the homes of elderly black people without warrants and tear the houses up, and the channels who produce news in Omaha have shown this on the news, and the Omaha legal department justifies it. And you know why they ran into these people's home? Because somebody said, I saw somebody shooting; they ran in that house. They go in the house. One of the houses had four or five old people, one of them was on a walker, the others sitting around scared to death. They thought the house was being robbed, because these were plain-clothes people who ran in and knocked the door down. That's what they do in my community, not yours, so you all think I'm lying. Well, if I'm lying, why doesn't the U.S. Attorney expose me and ruin me and destroy my credibility? If I'm lying, why doesn't the chief of police do it? When I talked about the DNA racist sweeps in my community, they couldn't discredit me, and fortunately enough of you were persuaded to pass a law so they cannot do that as easily. But some didn't want to believe that was happening. You don't face it. You go home and everything is nice. Not every young black man has a gun. Not every black man you see is going to shoot somebody, and we're not having somebody shot every day, but it happens enough...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to terrify people in a community. I was explaining to Senator Beutler that the family structure does not just consist of the parents and the biological children. There are extended families, which means in our community that there is no blood relationship there at all, but people treat each
