SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the motion say aye. Senator Chambers. Open for discussion. I was going to say that. Thanks for reminding me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's all right. Senator Landis, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, would some of these credits that are being discussed, and I don't want to go into all of that, would there...would there be areas in Omaha which might qualify for them also?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes. By census tract analysis, my guess is that north Omaha and south Omaha are the most likely areas in Omaha who...that would qualify for the use of these kinds of tax credits.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I wanted that on the record, and thank you, Senator Landis. That's all that I needed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, are you finished? The motion before the body is advance to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. All opposed to the motion say nay. It is readvanced. Mr. Clerk, items, please.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. New resolution: Senator Loudon offers LR 282 and LR 283; both those will be laid over. Your Committee on Government, chaired by Senator Schimek, reports LB 788, LB 920, LB 1013 as indefinitely postponed. A series of hearing notices: Natural Resources Committee, the Judiciary Committee, the Executive Board, and the Appropriations Committee, and the Urban Affairs Committee all offer hearing notices, Mr. President.
