SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning we have Senator Kremer to give us our opening prayer.

SENATOR KREMER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kremer, for doing that for us this morning. Senator Kremer represents the 34th District. I call the twentieth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: There is a quorum present this morning, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are there any corrections for the Journal?

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have no corrections this morning.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Reports, messages, or announcements?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, notice of committee hearing by the Government Committee. Your Committee on Banking reports LB 917 to General File with amendments; LB 864 indefinitely postponed; LB 1240 indefinitely postponed. Committee on Transportation reports LB 1085 to General File with amendments. Senator Kremer designates LB 856 as the Ag Committee's priority bill. I have a report of registered lobbyists for the current week, and a series of reports that have been received from state agencies that are on file in the office.
