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SENATOR LANGEMEIER: It would be unaddressed in this legislation. It is not...it would not be addressed if there's not a fee attached to it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So a person could still do that, if not for a fee?

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: Correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So it's not the activity itself; it's the charging of a fee for it?

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: Correct. Sorry.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, now I understand that. Did you follow my explanation of this first amendment that I have up there?

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I did.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you have any objection to it?

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I do not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Members of the Legislature, I will ask that this amendment be adopted.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on FA388 to LB 778. Open for discussion. Senator Smith.
