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SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...your staff already is...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, your time is up.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...surmising where I'm going with this, and I'll be right back.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, this time I will yield my time to Senator Beutler, so that he can continue where he is.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I will turn my light off, then turn it back on.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler.
