SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Oh, I...

SENATOR SCHROCK: I believe it's...

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...LB 870.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And was it advanced by the committee?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, it was advanced unanimous.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, Ash Grove would participate in this emissions trading program, wouldn't it?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Could.
