ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays to adopt committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments have been adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of advancement of LB 787. No lights on. Senator Mines waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 787 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye; those opposed, nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 787. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 787 does advance. Next agenda item is LB 792. Mr. Clerk, LB 792, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 792, introduced by Senator Fischer. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 4 of this year, referred to Natural Resources. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments. (AM1937, Legislative Journal page 423.)
