Services Committee. Open for discussion. Anybody wish to discuss the third report? Senator Jensen, there are no lights on. Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the confirmation report offered by the Health and Human Services Committee be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Voting on the confirmation report of the Health and Human Services Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 758-759.) 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The third report has been adopted. That concludes the first portion of our agenda. (Doctor of the day and visitors introduced.) We now move on to the next agenda item, Select File, 2006 committee first priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, may I read a couple items before?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may.

CLERK: Thank you. LR 292 is a new resolution offered by Senator Kremer; that will be laid over. Senator Schrock, an amendment to LR 259CA to be printed. (Legislative Journal pages 759-760.)

Mr. President, LB 975 on Select File. Enrollment and Review amendments were considered and adopted yesterday. Senator Schrock had offered AM2387. Subsequent to a request for division by Senator Beutler, the amendment was divided. Pending is what is Section 17 of the original AM2387, specifically FA485. (Legislative Journal page 750.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Schrock, you won't need to reopen, but being as we didn't get into your third division very far, let us review that, would you please?
