Baker speaks against the adoption of such amendment. I will listen closely to what they say and if they persuade me, I will withdraw the amendment. If they don't persuade me, then I will let it go to a vote, and whatever the body decides is what I may, what I may, accept without consequence being imposed. Senator Cudaback, the other day I had a little rhyme about amending bills. This one is different: The world as we know it / Will come to an end / Before there's a bill / That I cannot amend. You'd look at this bill and feel there's no reason or need to amend it. But I am interested in the way we legislate. Some of my amendments will deal with existing language in the law. So when one of the amendments will specify language and be followed the words "show as stricken," that means the language that I'm removing is a part of the existing law and not language put in by Senator Cudaback's amendment. Oh, my goodness! (Laughter) I just looked up at the seat being occupied by the person who has been placed in charge of this ship. (Laughter) You know what? If this were the Queen Mary, if this were the Andrea Doria, if this were the Titanic, it could be sailing in...

SENATOR BOURNE PRESIDING

SENATOR BOURNE: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...waters that have a temperature upward of 60, 70, or 80 degrees and the present captain would manage to find an iceberg and sink it. So I think we need to keep our fingers crossed, and those of you who may think you have any contact with the big ship captain upstairs, put in a word for all of us. But if the ship goes down, I'm abandoning. (Laughter) Thank you, Mr. President.
