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SENATOR JENSEN: I would hope that you would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you know that if I give a yes vote, it's based strictly on the credibility that you have with me.

SENATOR JENSEN: I would appreciate that, yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And neither one of us knows really whether a Dr. Hopp exists or not. Isn't that true?

SENATOR JENSEN: Not for certain do I know that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you think all these senators are going to vote for somebody who may not even exist, and you think that's what they're going to do this morning.

SENATOR JENSEN: They may.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you think they should?

SENATOR JENSEN: I think they should, based on the information that we've received.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Uh-huh. Further discussion, report? Seeing no lights on, Senator Jensen, did you wish to close?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes. Thank you. And I would ask the Legislature approve Russell Hopp, a new appointment to a four-year term to the State Board of Health.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction) Roll call vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion before the body is appointment of Russell Hopp, State Board of Health. Been a roll call vote on the question. Mr. Clerk, when you get time, please call the roll.
