34 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to invoke cloture, Mr. President.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: The amendment to the amendment is not adopted. We will now proceed to vote on AM1810 by Senator Cornett. All those in favor of the amendment signify by voting aye; those opposed, nay. A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk.
