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LB 856

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There really are, and I'm not being facetious.

SENATOR KREMER: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I won't be able to explore it further...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...at this point, because my time is running out. But when we come to the bill itself, then I'll have an opportunity to elaborate on that. SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA528. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted to LB 856? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. The question before the body is the Chambers amendment, FA528 to LB 856. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment has been adopted.
