ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to advance the bill, Madam
President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The bill does advance. Items for the record,
Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, I do. New resolution LR 306
by Senator Langemeier; LR 307 by Senator Langemeier. Amendments
to be printed to LB 287 by Senator Friend. Your Committee on
Judiciary reports LB 1096 to General File; LB 914 and LB 925 to
General File with amendments. I have an amendment to LB 1208
from Senator Raikes to be printed; LB 1060, Senator Don
Pederson; and LB 1060, Senator Langemeier. That's all I have at
this time. (Legislative Journal pages 1014-1019.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next item on the
agenda.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Next bill, Madam President, LB 1175. E & R
amendments have been adopted, as has an amendment from Senator
Friend. At this time, Senator Chambers would move to
indefinitely postpone the bill.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Chambers, would you like to open on
your motion?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, yes, although I do it with a
very heavy heart. This is Senator Beutler's shining hour, in a
sense, because he managed to have attached to this bill an
amendment that would allow Lincoln to enter into installment
contracts for the purchase of real property. I realize this
discussion is very exciting. The subject is exciting. Those
who have heart palpitations probably ought to excuse themselves
and not even listen. I see Senator Aguilar (laugh), but his
heart pulled him back down in his chair, just overcame him. I
had said earlier in the session that because Senator Landis was
involving himself in legislation sought by Omaha, which if
