SENATOR BOURNE:      Correct, and LB 1208, assuming it has an A bill?

SENATOR BEUTLER:      And LB 1208? Okay. Well, if you're going to do those two kinds of bills, Senator, you would have to look at lines 18 through 28...

SENATOR BOURNE:      Exactly.

SENATOR BEUTLER:      ...for appropriations bills. And then down lower, where you see "Impact of Bills Pending," do you see that category?

SENATOR BOURNE:      What line is that?

SENATOR BEUTLER:      It's actually--my eyes are getting bad--line 38.

SENATOR BOURNE:      Okay, so the first...

SENATOR BEUTLER:      Thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty, and forty-one would be what we call the A bills.

SENATOR BOURNE:      The middle box?

SENATOR BEUTLER:      The middle box, right. So starting with line 19, you have the 2005, last year's totals. And then LB 1060, you see that on the next line.

SENATOR BOURNE:      Correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER:      And you see the figures filled in. That's what your Appropriations Committee has in that bill right now. Then there's the claims bill. Then you see under that General File amendments.

SENATOR BOURNE:      Line 22?

SENATOR BEUTLER:      Line 22, and as those are adopted, we'll add or subtract to the figures above, okay? Is that...
