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SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you, Senator Pederson. There were seven lights on prior to this new amendment. If you wish to pass over or do not wish to talk, that's your option. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK:      Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I will be brief, but I want to rise in support of the Janssen amendment, and I want to remind people that this is pretty much a one-year deal. We'll have to come back and examine it again next year. I have some of the same concerns and expressed some of the same concerns that Senator Combs talked about earlier; that is that we need more information and we need to be more on top of this issue before next year rolls around. I reiterate the fact that my intent, and I hope it's the legislative intent, is to have more services provided and not to hurt some of the clinics that are already out there providing these services. So with that, I would just urge adoption of the Janssen amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you, Senator Schimek. Further discussion? Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN:      Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I have a little bit of a concern with this coming from working with the health department in my area. This health department serves these people immediately when they come in there and they have no problem, no backlog or anything like that. One concern that I really have, as a senator of, this is my fourth year, if we're going to put something in and put money into it and it's going to be a one-year deal, I don't know if I want to be a part of it. I don't know why we would do something and see how it works for one year. What I'm really concerned about is that these existing health departments, and mine included, you know, maybe the dollar amount given for this service may be lowered. Is there going to be a cap on how many of these health departments or clinics or anything like that will be available or will be awarded contracts for this? Are we going to allow them to start one year and choke them the next year? I hate to see something like that. I don't...I think we should be looking to the future. I don't know whether we should be putting it in just for a one-year deal. It should have...be
