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brought out of an unclean thing. So the fact that Legal Aid is going to be benefited, and Legal Aid provides services to those people most in need of them while being unable to afford them, it took away my adamant opposition. But in exchange for seeing something of benefit to Legal Aid, I had to concede something also. And Senator Bourne and Senator Flood are very interested in providing some money for that Law Enforcement Training Center, so I agreed to let the other \$1 go for that purpose. Then, as Senator Flood pointed out, there will be some General Fund money to make up the difference between what the Law Enforcement Training Center would have gotten from the entire \$2 and what they will get from the \$1. So I think it is a very good solution to what appeared to be an impasse that two of our younger members put together, so I am in favor of what is before us now and I hope the amendment, as presented by Senator Flood, will be adopted. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bourne, did you wish to use any remaining opening time? Thank you. That concludes the opening. We're ready for discussion on the amendment by Senator Flood and Senator Bourne. Senator Don Pederson.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. As mentioned by Senator Flood, this has been discussed and I'm in concurrence of this as far as the appropriations process is concerned. This will, of course, require some adjustments in the A bill, and so we're going to have to ask to have this passed over as far as the A bill is concerned, when we come to that, because we're in the process of making the appropriate modification. And it will also make some adjustment to the general budget because there's some General Funds that are involved that were mentioned in other facets here. So I think that we are in the process of working out the details but, in essence, I'm certainly in favor of this and I would concur with what Senator Chambers has said. This resolves many concerns that we've had. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pederson. Senator Bourne.
