CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 990A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 990A does advance. (Doctor of the day introduced.) Mr. Clerk, LB 956A.

CLERK: LB 956A by Senator Beutler. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, LB 956, you may recall, is the bill that creates the official position of performance auditor. And when that position is created, the Exec Board has the option that they may or may not take to increase that salary, and so this A bill affords the Exec Board that opportunity by appropriating \$15,000 each year. Now, they may or may not do that. They'll be looking at all the facts and trying to determine whether any pay increase whatsoever is justified, but we were advised that the money should be put in to give them the option. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the opening on LB 956A. For discussion? Senator Beutler, there are no lights on. Senator Beutler waives closing. Question before the body is, shall LB 956A advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 956A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 956A does advance. We now go to LB 1226A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1226A by Senator Schrock. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open.
