SENATOR CUDABACK: You heard the opening by Senator Schrock. Mr. Clerk, amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Langemeier would move to amend, AM2652.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Langemeier, to open.

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: Thank you, Mr. President. I'd ask to withdraw AM2652.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock would move to amend with AM2945. (Legislative Journal page 1301.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open on your amendment, AM2945.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, after conversation with the Chair of the Appropriations Committee, who said we're spending too much money, and he might say this is too much, too, we have cut the A bill in half. So it would be \$2.5 million a year for the Department of Natural Resources to use for water issues, basically for modeling so we know where we're at so we can implement LB 962 to determine whether our basins are fully appropriated; and \$2.5 million a year to be used for grants for our municipalities to be used for waste water issues. That is the content of the amendment. I would ask for your support.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Heard the opening on the Schrock amendment, AM2945, to LB 1226A. Open for discussion. Any lights on? Seeing no lights on, Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close. Senator Schrock. Did you wish to close, Senator Schrock? No lights on.
