SENATOR FLOOD: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 962A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 962A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed to the motion, nay. It is readvanced. We now go to LB 819, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Mines would move to return LB 819 to Select File for AM2547. (Legislative Journal page 874.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mines, to open on your motion to return.

SENATOR MINES: Thank you, Mr. President, colleagues. This would...my proposal would be to return the bill and add two provisions. One would reauthorize, or re...I guess reconstitute the Governor's selections on...based on congressional districts. And the second one would have to do with nonresident licensees, brokers, and nonresident realtors. So I'd ask your indulgence to return the bill to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to return. Open for discussion on that motion. There are no lights on. Senator Mines...waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 819 be returned for specific amendment? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The bill has been returned. Mister...

CLERK: AM2547, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mines, to open on AM2547.

SENATOR MINES: Thank you, Mr. President, colleagues. I did a lousy job (laugh) of introducing the reason to bring it back. Let me do better right now.
