served on committees with Senator Landis I think five out of my eight years in the Legislature, five out of the eight. I think it was three on Banking and two on Revenue, and there is not a better person in an executive session than Senator Landis. He's persuasive, he lulls you into this false sense of security, and pretty soon (laughter) you hand him your wallet. You say, here you go, Senator Landis, it's yours. It's like...I don't know. He should be a televangelist. (Laughter) I'm making light of the situation, but it's very serious. I think what we're doing here with the underlying bill is a huge policy change. To put territories on these entities is a big deal. I don't think the second component, obtaining permission, is that big a deal. That's just my sense; I haven't talked to anybody about it, but they're doing it now, so I don't think it's that big a deal. But I do believe exclusive territories is a huge policy change. We have the Chair of the Urban Affairs Committee saying we don't need to do this. Let's reconsider the motion, let's vote yes, let's adopt Senator Friend's amendment and move on. With that, I would urge your reconsideration.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. You've heard the closing on the motion to reconsider. Mr. Clerk, would you read the motion, please, before the body.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bourne would move to reconsider the vote on the adoption of AM2708 as an amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the motion to reconsider vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Voting on the motion to reconsider. Have you all voted who care to?

SENATOR BOURNE: Roll call vote in regular order, Mr. President.
