CLERK: LB 1060 has been returned by the Governor with certain line-item reductions. The first motion I have with respect to the bill is by Senator Don Pederson, the Chair of Appropriations. The Appropriations Committee would move that the particular line item relating to Section 208, Agency 26, Department of Health and Human Services, Section 208 for Qualified Community Health Centers, that provision become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.
