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provided for the students and the education systems where they provided assistance. So with that kind of information having been given, the body added to the budget the amount of money necessary to fund these positions. What was said on that day, which was a good day, holds true on this day. It would have been better never to have funded the positions than to fund them and let it be taken away. There are people who follow our deliberations and they are heartened when the Legislature does something which is beneficial. They in all cases are not aware that what was given can be taken away by the Governor. I don't see where this money should pose a controversy when we support Senator Connealy's motion to restore it. This is not money that will be frittered away. It goes directly toward rectifying problems that we all agree exist. I said before--and if I didn't, I wish I had, but I'll say it now--I don't know of any expenditure of this amount of money by the state which will result in so much quantifiable good. So I am in strong support of Senator Connealy's motion and I hope we will vote to restore this money. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. On with discussion, the motion to override. Senator Aguilar, followed by Senator Louden.

SENATOR AGUILAR: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I also rise in support of Senator Connealy's motion on this. One thing I'd like to touch on is, just like in the previous motion, this is one of those areas where, by spending this money, by spending this little bit of money, we get more back in return. You know, you've heard of how the hospitals are going to save, Medicaid is going to save on the previous motion. Well, you know, if we can save a couple kids here, you know, you can imagine what the dollar return on that would be. It would be huge. But I think this is a well worthwhile motion to consider and I'd ask that you all support it as well. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Aguilar. Senator Louden.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I, too, support Senator Connealy's amendment to override this part of the veto. This is something that's quite important for some of
