SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 817AE passes with the emergency clause attached. We now go to LB 872. The first vote will be to suspend the at-large reading. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Please record, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 35 ayes, 3 nays, on the motion to dispense with the at-large reading, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The at-large reading is dispensed with. Madam Clerk, please read the title of LB 872.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 872.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 872 pass? All in favor vote aye; all opposed to the motion vote nay. Record please, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1472-1473.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 872 passes. Madam Clerk, LB 872A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 872A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 872A pass? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1473-1474.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 872A passes. We now go to LB 990. The first vote will be to suspend the at-large reading pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Record please, Madam Clerk.
