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situation in Columbus, they're owned by the Platte County Ag Society, which is a nonprofit organization.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But even though they're called nonprofit organizations, the aim is to try to generate as much revenue as possible; is that true?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: That is true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And there's not enough interest in horse racing to generate that kind of revenue; is that true?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: There is an interest in horse racing, but the live meet, because of the expenses, it does not generate enough money to keep it going.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you want to bring in a type of gambling which can be equated to slot machines; is that true?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: I want to bring in another portion of horse racing, actual horse racing.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This is not...is a dead horse actually running?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: When the video, when the picture was taken, the horse was running, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Stuthman, is John Kennedy giving speeches today, John F. Kennedy?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: John F. Kennedy is, realistically, is not giving speeches personally.
