SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 228 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed vote nay. Voting on advancement of LB 228. Have you all voted on the motion who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Record please, Mr. Clerk. Senator Howard?

SENATOR HOWARD: I would request a roll call vote, sir, and a call of the house, as well.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are you requesting a call of the house first? We had not recorded yet. Requesting a call of the house?

SENATOR HOWARD: I would request a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senators, please check in. Senator Jensen, would you check in, please? Senator Chambers, would you check in, please? All members are present or accounted for.
