SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you, Senator Synowiecki.      Senator Raikes, you're recognized to close on LB 1024A.

The question before the body is advancement of LB 1024A. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Voting on advancement of LB 1024A. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      29 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the A bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      LB 1024A does advance. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?
