closing. AM3046 to LB 1113. All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed, nay. Voting on adoption of the Aguilar amendment, AM3046, that amends LB 1113. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Aguilar's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Aguilar amendment is adopted. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend, AM3114. (Legislative Journal page 1503.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the body, if I may have your attention, this is uncharacteristic of me. I don't ever remember filibustering a bill, and that's not my intent here. But I have grave concerns about an amendment that was added on General File, and I was unaware of it at the time. I believe if that amendment stays on this bill there will be no flood control projects built on the Papio NRD in the near future. A lawyer who represents the Papio NRD was in my office last week. I have been in daily contact with Marlin Peterman, the assistant manager up there, and I have grave concerns about this. I will tell you, I will work with you on any amendment to fix this. I would have interim studies with the Judiciary Committee, without...but I don't think it is prudent for us to pass this today. I think if we do pass it today, you'll be back next year to fix it, because I think it is that egregious. It is about landowners in Washington County that don't want flood control projects built on their property. That is what we're talking about. LB 1113 is an important bill. It has a lot of bills into it: LB 1009, dealing with the collection of DNA under the Sexual and Violent Offenders Act; LB 1047 prohibits the harassment of a stalking victim's family; LB 1070, child abuse investigative authority; LB 1075 adds the crime of sexual assault of a child; LB 1146, DNA testing as part of the criminal investigation; LB 1149, protective custody of foreign national minors; LB 1181, right to hearing for juvenile offenders;
