But I resent the fact that these NRDs are coming out of the woodwork at the eleventh hour and saying that, hey, it's okay to spend \$4 million of taxpayer money, and then let's give these lots to the fat cats so they can sell them for \$175,000 each. I don't know if Dean Epsom (sic) has one there, but this isn't right.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are you through, Senator Bourne?

SENATOR BOURNE: Do I have more time? (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've got about five seconds left. According to the Speaker's rules, announcement that we will be passing over LB 1113. We now go to Select File...correct, Mr. Clerk? 2006, Senator priority bills, LB 385.

CLERK: Senator Flood, I have Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 385, Senator. (AM7220, Legislative Journal page 1430.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Flood, please.

SENATOR FLOOD: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 385.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed, nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: First amendment to the bill I had from, it's from Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers had FA673 but I have a note that he wants to withdraw FA673, Mr. President, and offer as a substitute FA677. (Legislative Journal page 1590.)
