coming up with a proposal to address integration in a learning community would begin its effort; and a high-needs coordinating...coordinator for high-needs education programs would begin their operation. So those are the only four things that begin. All of the rest of it is targeted, but well within the reach of the Legislature to address as they consider the various comments and their own inputs and thoughts on the whole topic. I think it's very important that we change the starting point. I don't think it's well for us, having given all the attention we have to this issue, to go back to where we began the session and start there. I think that no doubt it's the case that at least one of the significant players would prefer that, but I don't think that's in the best interests of the Legislature. So I urge your support of this amendment. I assure you that this is within the scope of what we've talked about, even though it's a white copy amendment and it thereby is a thick one. Again, I urge your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the closing on AM3258. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
