Section 1. Section 18-2120, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 18-2120 (1) In carrying out a redevelopment project, an authority 4 may: (a) (1) Convey to the city in which the project is located, such 5 real property as, in accordance with the redevelopment plan, is to be laid out into streets, alleys, and public ways; (b) (2) grant servitudes, 6 7 easements, and rights-of-way, for public utilities, sewers, streets, and other similar facilities, in accordance with the redevelopment plan; and 8 9 (c) (3) convey to the municipality, county, or other appropriate public  $body_{\tau}$  such real property as, in accordance with the redevelopment plan, 10 is to be used for parks, schools, public buildings, facilities, or other 11 public purposes. 12

13 (2) In carrying out a redevelopment project within a city of the 14 metropolitan class for any project that includes a fixed rail or 15 streetcar system, an authority shall pay for all project-related costs 16 for natural gas and water utilities. Project-related costs shall include 17 any and all necessary utility work required for the construction of a 18 fixed rail or streetcar system and shall include engineering services 19 performed for any and all gas and water utility work.
